Also, the NSF Biological Oceanography Program in the Division of Ocean Sciences has issued a [Dear Colleague Letter](#) stating that it will eliminate target dates and accept proposals for consideration at any time after **January 1, 2021**.

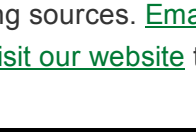
